

Classes will run as normal unless otherwise specified. We offer complimentary make-up sessions with the kids to make sure they have a full-grasp on the material. They will also have the option to send coaches recordings and receive feedback on these exercises

Are students required to attend tournaments?

No. While we encourage all students to compete and our advanced debate curriculum is based around regular competition, you are not required to attend tournaments as part of the course.

How do I track progress?

We work with parents to set learning goals at the beginning of the course, email individualized updates after every class, and send out longer progress reports at the middle and the end of the program. We are also always happy to speak to parents and address specific concerns as needed.
